



F. L. Elder Annual Award For Outstanding Reporting in Education Nomination

Entry Deadline: August 22, 2022

Purpose:

To recognize professional reporting that explains:

- Educational issues in a way that leads to a better public understanding of education,
- Describes how the community can work with schools to increase student opportunities,
- Examines educational practice in schools and districts, and
- Discusses trends in schools and their impact on communities.

Acceptable feature entries:

1. Single article/feature: a stand alone article
2. Editorial/Column: one piece that expresses the publication's position or the writer's opinion
3. Series: a group of articles comprising a series, and
4. Supplement: a special section on a general educational topic printed in one issue of a publication.

Areas of Entry:

1. Print reporters
2. Media reporters
3. School public relations personnel (Must be an internal publication)

Nomination:

Based on the criteria above, submit a one-page summary including examples, explaining why the reporter deserves the award and meets the four purposes of the award. Entries must have been published between May 2021 and May 2022.
