Entry Deadline: August 17, 2021

Purpose:

The Texas Educators Achieving Classroom Honors award recognizes an innovative educator for their efforts in the classroom that impact the students they teach and inspire other educational professionals. This award is for the 2020-2021 school year.

Eligibility:

Teachers with less than 5 years of classroom experience who teach PK-12.

Criteria:

- Effective classroom teaching practices
- Serves as a mentor and inspiration to students
- Challenges students to achieve at a higher level

The winning educator will receive:

- Recognition at the Texas ASCD Annual Conference
- Travel, hotel, and conference registration
- One year Texas ASCD membership
- Recognition in a Texas ASCD publication

The winning educator's campus principal will receive:

- Recognition at the Texas ASCD Annual Conference
- One year Texas ASCD membership

Nomination:

Based on the criteria above, submit a one-page summary including examples, explaining why the educator deserves the award. A student, teacher, or principal familiar with the teaching practices of the educator may submit a nomination.
